August Training: The Practical Map & Compass 8/10, 7-8:30PM, Cary Senior Center

Come join Cary CERT's George Dolicker in a follow-up to last month's map plotting class. This month we will use a compass to take bearings and fixes on distant objects, learn quick compass references to confirm our progress along a route, accurately measure distances as we walk, and navigate along a precision route outside using compass bearings and step counts. We will also learn how to make a manual pace counting tool to keep track of your distance travelled. **Please bring a magnetic compass, a pencil, and a notebook.**

July Training: Map Reading and Using a Compass 7/13, 7-8:30PM, Cary Senior Center

Civil Air Patrol Lt. Col Pete Bohler presented a hands-on, practical session on map reading and coordinates using state-of-the-art <u>SARTOPO tools</u>. Providing each attendee with a very portable transparent map overlay, Pete showed the team how to find the grid coordinates for their location on a map, and how to find the point on a map indicated by a set of USNG coordinates (different that latitude/longitude), and then challenged everyone to perform both skills on their own.

But there's still more to do to get that national credential: you have to complete your <u>CERT Volunteer Position Task Book</u> that documents YOUR experience in CERT functions... and we're here to help! Both the NC CERTEX on September 30th and the Cary CERT Full-Scale exercise on November 4th are aligned to help you complete many of your task book requirements.
